

Proposed Town Forest

An extraordinary parcel of 118 acres of wooded land, with frontage on Wilson Pond has come to the town of Wayne for nonpayment of taxes. This property has been identified by Wayne's Conservation Commission as having potential for XC skiing and walking trails, and for providing good wildlife habitat. The town is considering several management plans. One proposal is that the town keeps this land as a Town Forest, allowing public access and promoting conservation. Since this property includes 1500 feet of frontage on the west shore of upper Wilson Pond, the BDW Ponds Watershed Association is very interested in the town's decision for this parcel's management and will keep the association's members informed as plans develop.
